The Gospel of John was written by the beloved disciple John. He states his intent for writing it with perfect clarity. “These (signs) are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name” (John 20:31). John arranges Jesus’ ministry and teachings around seven signs (or miracles) and seven “I AM” statements. He admits that “there are also many other things that Jesus did. Were every one of them to be written...the world itself could not contain the books that would be written” (21:25). And yet, by employing the number seven—the number of fullness or completion—John effectively communicates an evangelistic argument for faith in Jesus. It is also through the “I AM” sayings that we come to understand the Christ who is formed in us, and it is through His seven miracles that we come to believe in His power which is now at work in and through us. As we come to the end of John, we are invited to embrace the Spirit-filled life that Jesus embodied on earth, and we are invited to live as His Kingdom people, filled with hope by the resurrection, and walking in the same power and love of our Savior.
